Hawk Club is in full swing! Please find our daily schedule on the back on this newsletter. Also, our monthly enrichment calendar is hanging up in our main room for your viewing.

Every Monday we have been engaging in art for a special project you will see in December 😊 We also have been expanding our social-emotional learning through "Stanford Harmony" lessons every Monday as well. Homework

We provide quiet homework time Mondays-Thursdays for 1 hour from 3:45-4:45pm. All students are expected to engage in the 1 hour of academic activities as part of the ASES grant requirements.

Although we provide this 1 hour for homework, for some students this may not be enough time to complete and have their homework checked by our staff. Please make sure to still check your student's homework daily.

We also have Chromebooks/iPad minis for our students' use and we do our best to rotate their use among all the grades. If technology is being used for activities other than homework, students will lose the use of the technology for the remainder of the week or the entire following week.

Reminders...

Please remember to **call or email us if your student is going to be absent** from Hawk Club.

Having your student come tell us they are going to be absent is not an acceptable form of notification and they will be required to stay with us unless we have received a phone call or email from an authorized adult telling us they need to be picked up from the front of the school. Remember, it is all about your child's SAFETY!

Please remember that only authorized adults (18+) listed on the emergency card are allowed to sign out your student. This is a district wide policy. If you would like someone to pick up your student **one** time you must give us written & dated permission. If you need someone to begin picking up regularly, then you must add them to the emergency card.

Please also remember your student(s) can only have 3 unexcused absences per school year at Hawk Club. If your student is picked up before their authorized early release pick up time, then it is considered an unexcused absence without documentation. The ASES grant is based on student attendance and funding can be decreased if the requirements are not met.
